New Brunswick Qualified Welding Licenses Rules for Out of Province Transfer

Subject to the conditions listed below: The following out of province licenses may be recognized as equivalent. A New Brunswick Qualified (F3/F4) License may be issued without practical testing to holders of:

Newfoundland	GSC 001
Prince Edward Island	PEI 001
Nova Scotia	NSO1 or NSO3
Quebec	"B" pressure
Ontario	TSSA issued F3/F4
Manitoba	F3/F4 or F4
Saskatchewan	F3/F4
Alberta	Alberta "B"
British Columbia	BC-P-100

Welders that hold of any of the above licenses shall provide suitable documentation to confirm continuity has been maintained within the last 6 months and shall provide a photo ID that lists their current address such as a driver's license. The jurisdiction that issued the welding license being produced for transfer must be the same as the driver's license. We will not issue a Qualified license to an already transferred license.

If the welder does not hold one of the above or acceptable documentation of continuity is not available the individual shall apply for a performance qualification test for a NB Qualified licence. Applications will be evaluated to the requirements of New Brunswick Regulation 84-174 which requires documented practical welding experience of at least two years, 12 months of which was on pressure piping. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide objective evidence of their individual welding experience including the minimum 1 year on pressure piping. Upon review and acceptance the applicant will be administered a NB Qualified performance qualification test. (5" SCH 80 pipe 6G- F3/F4) 4HR time limit before a NB Qualified will be issued.
