Dear Members of the Board of Governors,

I am pleased to announce that on June 1, 2016, Joseph Maloney was officially appointed to the Board of Governors as a member of the Construction-Employee constituency. Joe is International Vice President for Canada of the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers.

Born and raised in Toronto, Joe has been a member of the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers since 1974. He got started as an apprentice in Local 128, where he served in many elected offices including Business Manager. In 1991 Joe was a member of the Governor General's Canadian Studies Tour. In 1992, he was appointed International Organizer representing Eastern Canada.

Joe graduated from the Harvard University Trade Union Program in 1993, and shortly thereafter was appointed as Director of the Canadian Office for the Building and Construction Trades Department, AFL-CIO in Ottawa.

He was elected Secretary-Treasurer of the Building and Construction Trades Department, AFL-CIO in January, 2000. Through its affiliated international unions, the Department, based in Washington, DC, represents more than three million tradespeople throughout North America.

At the Building Trades Department, Joe was the driving force in the establishment of Helmets to Hardhats, which links returning military veterans to job and training opportunities in union trades. McGraw Hill Publishing's ENR Magazine named Joe Maloney "2005 Man of the Year" for his work in creating this innovative and outstanding program. Joe was also the driving force behind the Canadian H2H program which was announced in 2011.

In October, 2005 Joe decided to return to his roots and served as International Vice President for the Boilermakers International representing Western Canada. On July 1, 2014, Joe was named the International Vice-President of Canada.

Please join me in welcoming Joe to the Ontario College of Trades Board of Governors and wishing him every success as he assumes this key role.
